

Sacral nodes drain to common iliac nodes.

Common iliac nodes drain to paraortic/lumbar nodes.

Lymph from great saphenous vein goes to vertical superficial gp going to external nodes.

External & internal nodes drain to common iliac nodes.

Lymph from small saphenous goes to popliteal which combines w/ deep nodes

superficial inguinal (horizontal) drain skin of abdomen below umbilicus, skin of gluteal region, anal canal below pectinate line, & all of superficial pouch except testes/ovaries

Deep nodes accompany deep vein of legs to go to popliteal & follow up.

underneath fascia to go to external & common iliac nodes.
