

## How To Draw: English Tack



## Bridle & Reins



Start with a red line around the nose for a noseband and, then a small blue circle for the bit





Use more red lines to draw the rest of the bridle, using 2 blue lines as buckles.





Change the red to either black or brown, and the blue to either gold of silver.





Do a black line to attract to the bit and up to the shoulder of the horse, then do a black line from behind the neck to be the reins.




## Saddle


Draw a red circle, a small circle over it and an oval behind it on the horses back for base of the saddle.




Then draw a blue line between the ova and circle. Also draw a line down, and a line on the side for stirrup lead, then do a red semicircle with a lime under it for the stirrup.



Make the red and blue to either black or brown, and the stirrup to either silver or gold.







## Saddle Pad

- 2. Draw a black outline around the pad and erase the red










Girth
