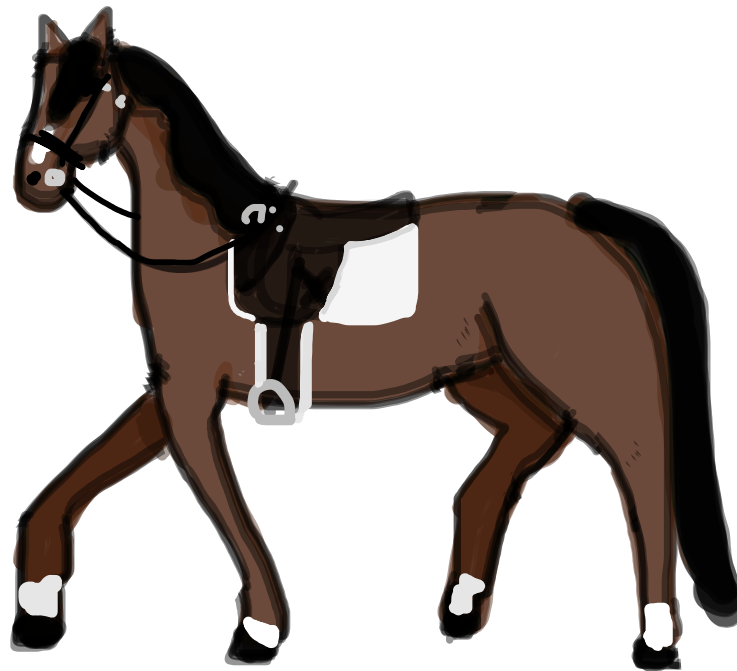


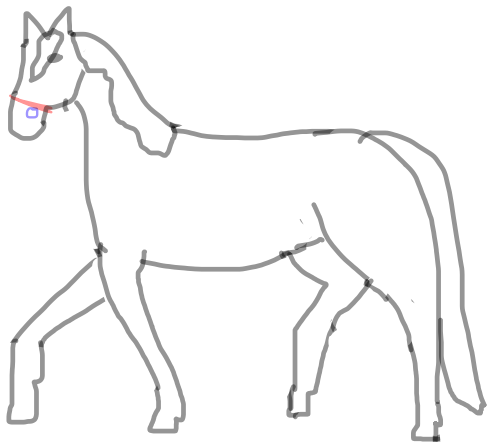
How To Draw: English Tack



Bridle & Reins

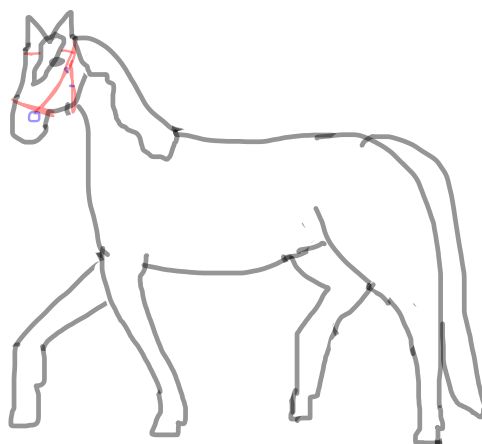
1

Start with a red line around the nose for a noseband and, then a small blue circle for the bit



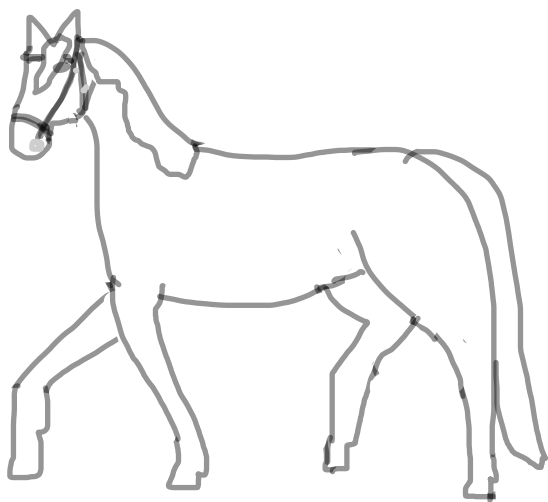
2.

Use more red lines to draw the rest of the bridle, using 2 blue lines as buckles.



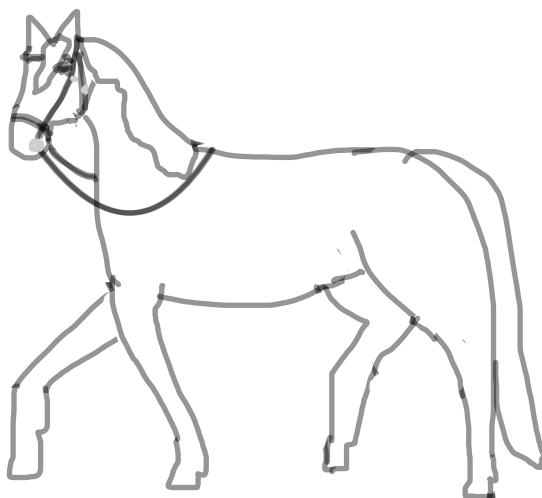
3.

Change the red to either black or brown, and the blue to either gold or silver.



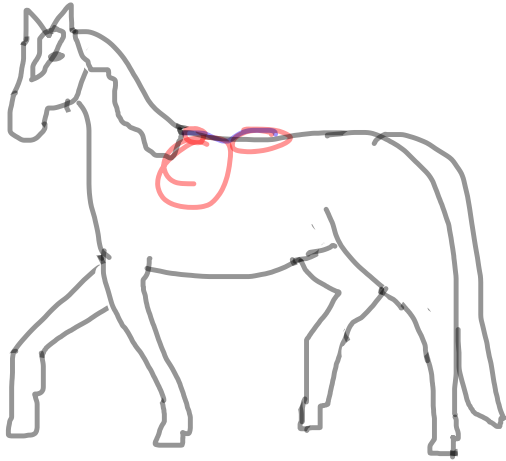
4.

Do a black line to attract to the bit and up to the shoulder of the horse, then do a black line from behind the neck to be the reins.

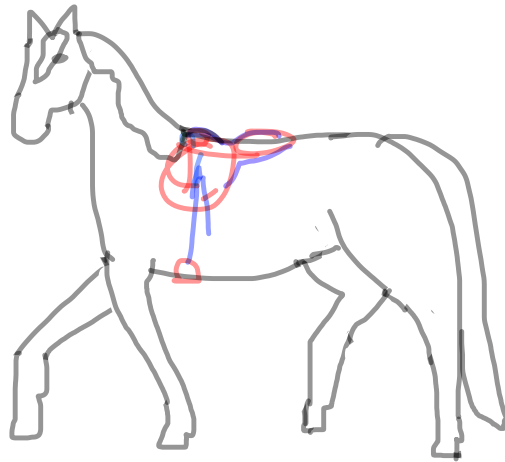


Saddle

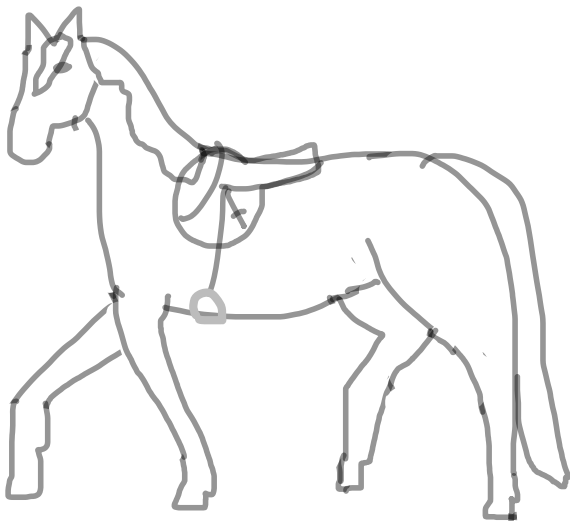
1. Draw a red circle, a small circle over it and an oval behind it on the horses back for base of the saddle.



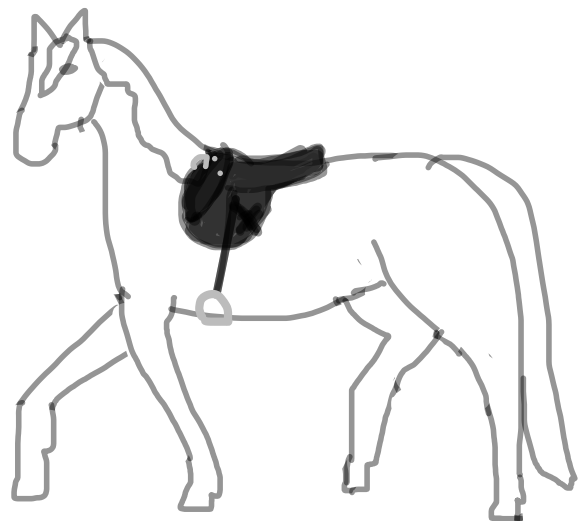
2. Then draw a blue line between the ova and circle. Also draw a line down, and a line on the side for stirrup lead, then do a red semicircle with a line under it for the stirrup.



3. Make the red and blue to either black or brown, and the stirrup to either silver or gold.

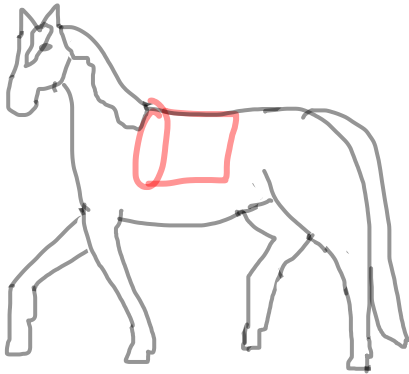


4. Colour it in.

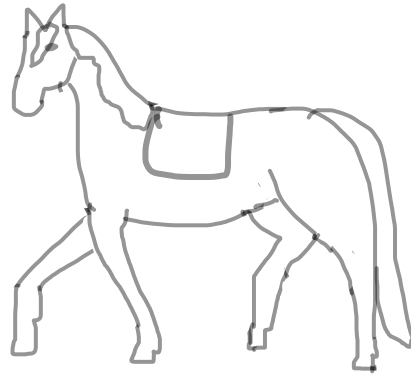


Saddle Pad

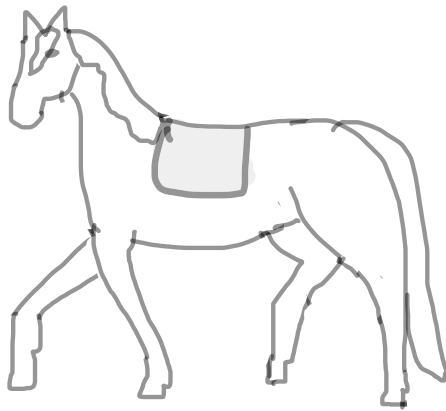
1. Draw an oval and square on the horse's back.



2. Draw a black outline around the pad and erase the red.

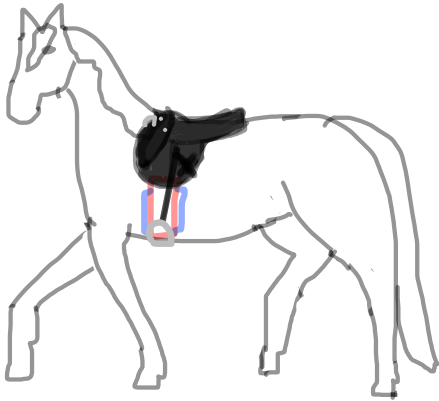


3. Colour it in whatever colour you want.

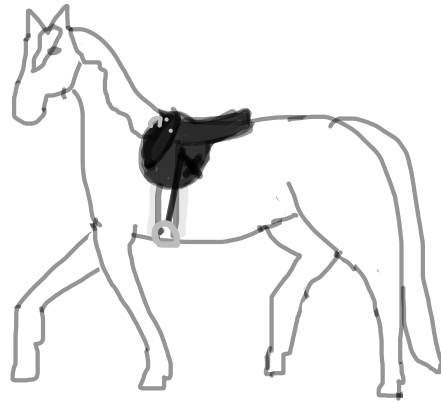


Girth

1 Draw a red. Rectangle with a small blue rectangle on each side.
(You need a saddle for this)



2. Make the blue light grey or tan, and the red black or brown



3. Colour the girth in with the colour you picked.
