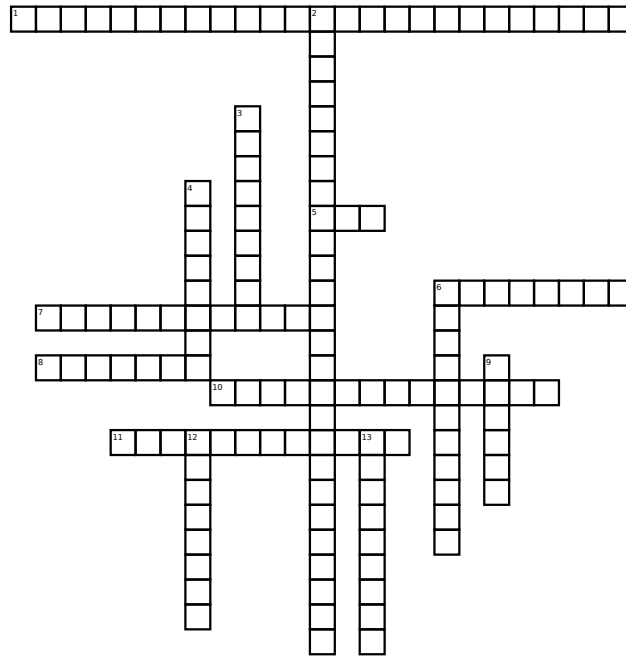

2. synthesizes lipids, phospholipids as in plasma membranes, and steroids
3. each of a number of flattened sacs inside a chloroplast, bounded by pigmented membranes on which the light reactions of photosynthesis take place, and arranged in stacks or grana
4. helps make proteins
6. the natural compound present in green plants that gives them their color
9. the supporting framework of an animal organ typically consisting of connective tissue
12. "trash man" of the cell
13. membrane-bound organelle that contains the cell's chromosomes.

1. series of connected flattened sacs, part of a continuous membrane organelle in the cytoplasm of eukaryotic cells
5. "blueprints" for the cell
6. gives plant cells their shapes
7. power house of the cell
8. stores water
