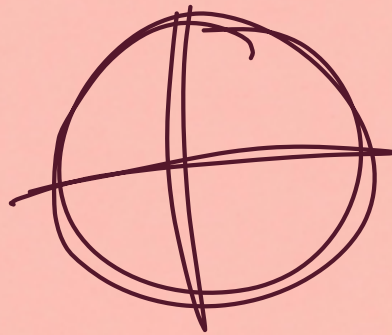


How I draw:

(next page)

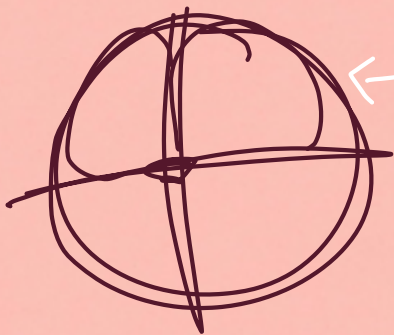
Step # 1: Add Guidelines



these are optional
but they can
sometimes help

Very simple step. Just sketch a circle and some lines. It doesn't have to be perfect at all but if you really want to, you could use the circle tool.

Step # 2: Add eyes + a nose



← Preferably connected

(optional):
Draw a line through the eyes



+ add a
mouth and
other
details!

Again, it doesn't have to be perfect at all. You can always change them later

Optional:
Don't follow this step by step. Try taking creative liberties!

Step #3: Head fluff

I'll be using this one



This step is completely up in the air. Just try what you like best; Make up your own

Step #4: Ears

The style is really up to you on this one as well

+ extra detail if wanted



(not this one though) ← ears + cheek fluff are both one stroke (for me anyways)

Step #5: Erasing Guidelines



Carefully draw a line along the chin



use the "whole" eraser to erase the guidelines

YOU can always make adjustments here. If you dislike the headshape after erasing the guidelines, then erase the chin and redo it (without the guidelines)



TADA!!

I also made other adjustments like changing the nose + adding eyelashes. These are not required and are all up to you!
