Military

Total Military Personnel: 507,852 (0.61% of the total population).

Active Military: 250,754 (0.30% of the total population).

Maximum Military Manpower: 2,302,131 (2.76% of the total population).

This is the total amount of able bodied citizens who could take up arms if necessary, regardless of age, sex and military experience.

They are seen as a pacifistic nation.
They have a defensive pact with 2 other countries.
Their military equipment is modern but ineffective.
They have voluntary military service for adults.

Economy

Unemployment rate: 7% of the population is unemployed.
Poverty rate: 4% of the population lives in poverty.
Literacy rate: 96% of the population can read and write.
They have fair technological capabilities but restrict access to worldwide communications networks.
Resources: Hetele is rich in natural resources, particularly:
1 - Marble,
2 - Bronze,
3 - Diamond,
4 - Minerals, and
5 - Aluminium.

Expenses show the minimum your characters need to survive for a month, and Wages suggest how much they'd normally earn in a month.

This may be a good starting point for your protagonist before they begin their epic journey to fame, glory, and of course, riches!

PEASANT EXPENSES (MONTHLY)

Food and provisions: (50) Copper Crown / (4) Silver Piece.

Rent and/or taxes: (24) Silver Piece / (0.99) Gold Part.

Misc: (32) Silver Piece / (1.31) Gold Part.

Total: (59) Silver Piece / (2.47) Gold Part.

INCOME (MONTHLY)

A peasant farmer's earnings: (136) Silver Piece / (5.68) Gold Part.

An average citizen's earnings: (304) Silver Piece / (12.66) Gold Part.

PROPERTY

A house; cramped but adequate: (968) Silver Piece / (40.35) Gold Part.

A house; average for a peasant: (9,394) Silver Piece / (391.42) Gold Part.

A "cheap" luxury house/mansion: (46,970) Silver Piece / (1,957.10) Gold Part.

ADVENTURING/MISC

A room and meal at an inn: (55) Copper Crown / (4) Silver Piece.

A basic horse and its trappings: (518) Silver Piece / (21.57) Gold Part.

A week's travelling provisions: (249) Copper Crown / (19) Silver Piece.
