5- Gir has a bed somewhere in Zim's base/ house.

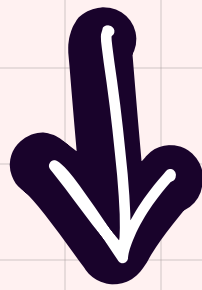
6- Gir will sometimes start randomly poking Zim.

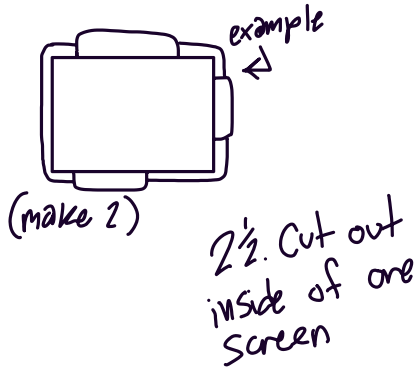
COME DOWN HERE FOR THE DIY!



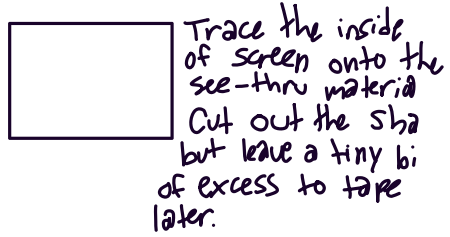
1. Gather materials

- paper
- Markers (or any coloring utensil)
- scissors
- Pen
- See through material that can be drawn on (e.g: tracing paper, parchment)

2. Draw the screens



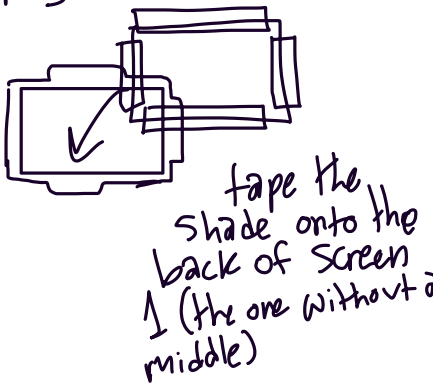
3. Make the shade/tint



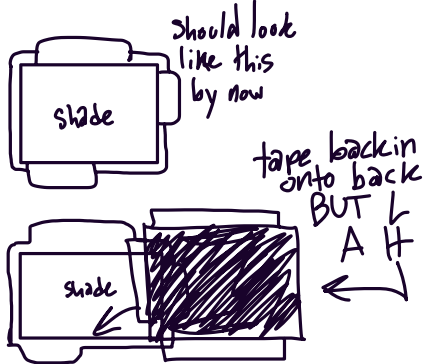
4. Color

Color the screen border & the shade. You can also color the second screen, as it will be taped behind the screen. I would use a dark color for the screen backing & a very light color for the shade so you can see your insert → #

5. Taping shade



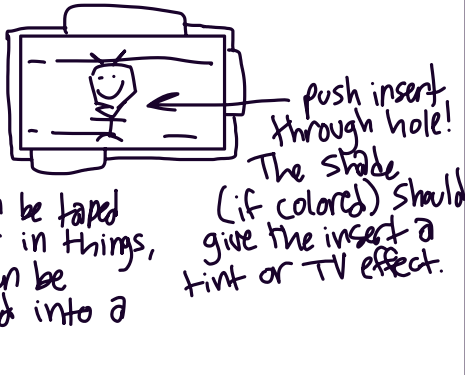
6. Taping back



7. Make insert

Draw anything you like, as long as it fits in the screen. Push into hole, good/colored side facing the shade.

Extra Info:
Screen/ TV can be any size.

For a TV effect, put slightly darker lines across your shade.

To ensure your shade isn't so dark it hides the insert, I suggest making it a light color. But if you want to make the shade darker, I recommend coloring both sides of the shade to give a darker effect.
