



A map that shows the outline of landforms is a physical map. Some landforms found on a physical map include mountains, plains, plateaus, canyons, lowlands, and piedmonts.

A relief map is a type of physical map that shows elevations and depressions on the earth's surface by using shading or colors. A relief map shows the ruggedness or flatness of the earth's surface.
