Tip: highlight the ones that you can remember easily. Do not highlight it if you "kinda" remember. The goal is to memorize every single one.

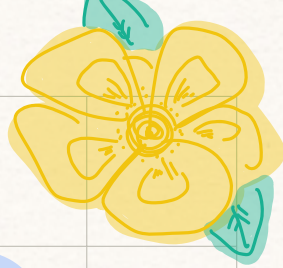
**to remember**
