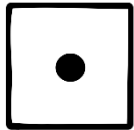

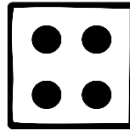

Instructions: In this activity, you will use a dice to roll parts of the setting you will be writing. Once you have rolled all of your setting elements, go ahead and start writing!

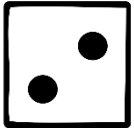
