- by adding "to" in front of the word

- for Spanish it's -ar, -er, and -ir

Stem/ending *comer* or *estudiar*

doesn't = no trabajar = work



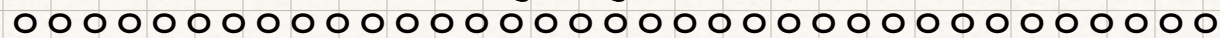
Gustar- to like

Me gusta la pizza- i like the pizza/ i like pizza



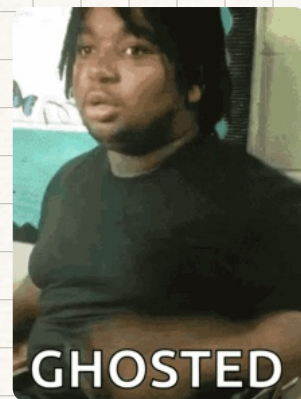
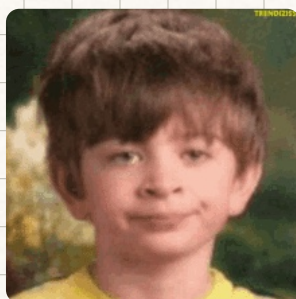
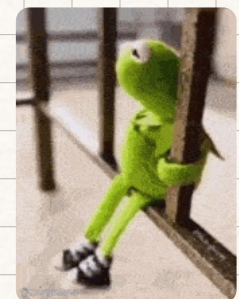
Me gustan los machos- i like men 🍷

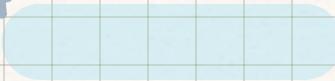
